Kim Kerr currently serves as the founding Director of Partners International Women, the women's initiative of Partners International. Her efforts are entirely focused on local women leaders in Africa, Asia, and the Middle East and their unique and distinct role in bringing the power, love, and light of Jesus Christ to some of the darkest places in our world today.

Women are the key to the culture and have unique and unparalleled opportunities to influence and train the next generation. With this in mind, Partners International Women has recently increased its ministry focus to include the work of women leaders serving children in their specific region of Africa, Asia, and the Middle East.



Kim leads a team of highly qualified women leaders who mobilize other women leaders both in the global south and the global north to empower and equip women in their localities in various capacity-building activities identified as: Heart, Head, Hands, Health and Home (Home includes children's ministry).

Women in America are eager to connect with our international women's ministry through their small groups, churches, families and professional service teams as advocates and prayer partners.

Prior to joining the Partners team, Kim served as the Executive Director of ONE Woman, the women's ministry of Mission ONE for 5 years, and as Executive Director of LifeCare Ministries, a holistic pro-life ministry for 10 years and led a team of 8 staff members and over 100 volunteers.

Women's ministry has been a major part of Kim's life from the start. Her training includes both formal training with Moody Bible Institute, Palm Beach Atlantic University, and Trinity Seminary, and non-

formal training in various leadership workshops, conferences, and ongoing courses for her service in the church, community, and global networks.

She has written and now taught her “Women in the Window” narrative inductive Bible study to women in Morocco, Ethiopia, Kenya, Sudan, Senegal, Thailand, India, Cambodia, Vietnam, and Indonesia and is now preparing a version of Women in the Window for Western women.

One of her favorite verses is Isaiah 40:31, “Yet those who wait for the LORD will gain new strength; they will mount up with wings like eagles, they will run and not get tired, they will walk and not become weary” because it describes the transformational love of Christ that she has so freely received. As someone who intimately knows the tender mercies of the Lord, her heart’s desire is to bring women face to face with the amazing love and grace so freely and abundantly found in Christ Jesus.
