



Frequently Asked Questions

What is 40 for the 10/40?

40 for the 10/40 is a unique opportunity to raise awareness in your congregation concerning the 2 billion people living in the 10/40 Window who are among the least reached and least resourced people in the world. The majority of these people live in highly restricted areas where there is little Christian witness or resources and where western missionaries typically cannot go. Additionally, the majority of these people live on less than \$10 a day—and in some places, even less than \$2 a day. After learning about the needs of the least reached, members of your congregation will be given the opportunity to give 40% of one day's income (typically around \$70) so the Gospel can be shared with people living in the 10/40 Window.

How much time will it take during our services?

The initiative will take place over the course of four weeks. On the first week, the initiative will be introduced with a brief verbal announcement, followed by a short video (under 3 minutes). Each of the following three weeks there will be another brief video explaining a different aspect of the plight and needs of the unreached in the 10/40 Window. After the last video on the fourth week, the congregation will be given the opportunity to give 40% of one day's income to help build the Church in the least reached places. Total time required is about 3 minutes per service.

What will it require of our team?

Each week someone will need to announce the video (30 seconds) and then you will need to have the capability to project the video. If the church has the capability for electronic giving, it would be ideal to set up a temporary account labeled "40 for the 10/40" or "Special Missions Offering" or whatever will enable you to identify the electronic giving for those who choose to give via credit or debit card. Instruct people to make checks out **to the church and designate "40 for the 10/40" in the memo line**. The church will then tabulate the total giving and provide a check in that amount to "Partners International" with the designation "40 for the 10/40". Where will the money go and how will it be used?

All money given will go to the mission of building the Church in the least reached places. If you would like your money to go to a specific region of the 10/40 Window or to a particular initiative such as empowering women, supporting ministry workers, caring for children, or transformative community development, that can be determined with your Partners International Representative prior to starting the initiative.

Will we get any follow-up reports?

You will be informed of opportunities to have one of our indigenous Ministry Partners give a brief report about how the Gospel is being shared and the Church is being expanded in the 10/40 Window when they are in your area. We will also make sure you are aware of any other ministry opportunities to invest into indigenous ministry workers in the 10/40 Window through Partners International.
